

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING OF LADOCK PARISH COUNCIL MONDAY 11 MARCH 2024

Following the notice, the Annual Parish Meeting of Ladock Parish Council was held on Monday 11 March 2024 at Sir Robert Harvey Memorial Hall, Grampound Road, commencing at 7pm.

PRESENT

1 CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME AND ANNUAL REPORT

Cllr Hartley welcomed all to the Parish Meeting. Throughout the year the Parish Council announced the Proclamation of King Charles III, welcomed Cllrs Buchan and Miners to the Council and Cllr Glasson welcomed a new baby. Some of the Parish Council's activities included cutting of footpaths and bridleways, cutting of grass in Ladock play field, 2 new grit bins installed in Ladock, Hedgehog highways purchased and distributed to community, had a stand at Ladockfest, new Facebook page, representation at CAP meetings, agreed to cover annual maintenance costs of Ladock and Grampound Road defibrillators, annual audit completed with no areas of concern, feasibility study for road safety measures in Ladock village, made representations on planning applications, representations at Planning Committee and also planning enforcements. Ongoing activities include bus shelter maps, painting of boundary and milestones and HE social fund application.

He was also concerned about leaves from plants in Grampound Road Playing Field. Chairman said he would raise issue with Playing Field Committee and also to report state of road to Cornwall Council on their 'Report It' site.
