Difficulty arranging date with Highways Manager and Cllr Donnithorne, but has been told that moving speed limit in lane to Ladock no possible as deemed safe, good visibility and no properties fronting area. CC considering reinstating verge in the area. Parking by Grampound Road Shop. Only options are yellow lines or other restrictions. Ladock. Road safety measures commencing on 10 February. Ditching CC will clear ditches on lane from Cregan Gate before end of financial year.
