

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF LADOCK PARISH COUNCIL – MONDAY 10 MARCH 2025

ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

Following The notice, the Annual Parish Meeting of Ladock Parish Council was held on Monday 10 March 2025 at Sir Robert Harvey Memorial Hall, Grampound Road, commencing at 7.00pm.

PRESENT

Cllrs Campbell (Chair), Barker, Buchan, Butler, Clemow, Hartley, Howes, Miners and Scott. Also present were 5 members of the public and the Clerk.

1 CHAIRMAN’S WELCOME AND ANNUAL REPORT. Cllr Campbell welcomed the public and updated on achievements throughout the year, including co-opting 2 new councillors, audit completed with no actions required, bus shelter maps completed and reproduced as leaflets and also for Ladock hall. The Parish Council took part in Remembrance Services in both Ladock and Grampound Road. Tree safety works to trees on PC land, footpaths and bridleways maintained and gate replaced at Guerlain bridleway. In Ladock village there is a new notice board, traffic calming measures and gateways introduced, new sign reminding drivers to slow down, remodelling of the crossing from Church Hill. In Grampound Road the pathway from St Ewe Eggs has been installed, Jubilee Oak replaced considering feasibility of adopting green space at Greenbank/Ventonlace and also continue to work with local residents and Cllr Glasson to overcome problems with traffic speeds and parking.

2 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE. Apology received and accepted from Cornwall Cllr Glasson.

3 APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PARISH MEETING HELD ON 11 MARCH 2024. Proposed by Cllr Hartley, seconded by Cllr Butler that the Minutes be signed as a true copy. Approved and signed by Chairman.

4 MATTERS FROM THE FLOOR. All five members of the public spoke of concerns regarding road safety in Menna. They reported that there were 3 serious incidents in the last year and traffic frequently exceeds the 40mph limit. They were also concerned about safety at Scarcewater crossroad. It was agreed that this would be an agenda item for April.

5 FINANCE

5.1 PRECEPT FOR 2025-26. The precept for 2025-26 is set at £25,420.

5.2 CONFIRMATION OF INCOME RECEIVED. All income received, including precept, VAT refund, local maintenance partnership reimbursement and 3 x peppercorn rents.

5.3 COMMUNITY BENEFIT FUND. The balance stands at £39,114.43.

6 CONFIRMATION OF DATES AND VENUES OF MEETINGS FOR 2025-26. Details had been circulated. Full Council meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of each month except August. All meetings are held at Sir Robert Harvey Memorial Hall, Grampound Road.
