Developers of Alice Meadows have not paid \$106 money to CC. Clerk attended Neighbourhood Priority Statement training, which emphasised the role they play in planning. She also attended Parish Online's training on Assertion 10. All successful applicants for Community Benefit grants have thanked the PC.

- 6 UPDATE ON TELECOMMUNICATIONS RESILIENCE PLANNING. Cllr Campbell attended meeting with Ladock hall committee, who are happy for storage use. Discussion on the use of powerpack and generator. ONGOING
- 7 UPDATE ON ACTIONS FOR REMEMBRANCE DAY. Poppy wreaths purchased. Cllr Cordingley-Clark to lay wreath at Ladock church. Cllr Hartley has arranged service at memorial trees in Grampound Road on 11 November, pupils from Grampound Road School to attend. RESOLVED

- 8 UPDATE ON PAINTING OF BOUNDARY AND MILESTONES. Original contractor did not do the work. Cllr Hartley was arranging for the work to be done with another contractor. £500 maximum amount. Require sight of public liability and qualifications. ONGOING
- 9 UPDATE ON CC SITE VISIT/ADVICE FOR VAS IN GRAMPOUND ROAD. ONGOING
- 10 UPDATE ON ENHANCED LMP GRANTS. Clerk had listed suggested works. Proposed by Cllr Hartley, seconded by Cllr Wells to proceed with request for grant for works to bridleway 16 (Muddy Lane) to resurface muddy area at eastern gateway; footpath 19 (Milay Lane to Ladock) repair kissing gate and cut back vegetation at Church Hill and bridleway 20 (Besigga/Gunnamanning to Trendeal), middle gateway to be widened, gate at Besigga to be lifted, horse friendly self-closing latches on all gates, holly tree above Besigga to be cut well back, barbed wire near gate above Besigga to be replaced with wood and stones to be removed from track above Besigga. All in favour. Cllr Cordingley-Clark to arrange for estimate to enable grant request to proceed. AGREED/ONGOING
- 11 CONSIDER ACTION FOR VEGETATION DAMAGE TO BUS SHELTER IN GRAMPOUND ROAD. Cllr Hartley to contact owner of adjacent garden and to tidy vegetation and repair bus shelter roof. AGREED
- 12 CONSIDER ACTION FOR GREEN SPACE AT GREENBANK CLOSE, COSTINGS OF PROPOSAL AND WHETHER TO PROCEED. Cllr Buchan had circulated some costings. Discussion around levelling divets, installing bench, ongoing maintenance etc. Cllr Glasson to look into cost of legal fees. Clerk explained we could not rely on local residents mowing lawn. Decided more details required before making decision. ONGOING
